# Cargo Bike

**Cargo Bikes** were popular in Europe during the mid 1900s and are still in use today. This elegant hand-made retro bicycle is designed to carry a maximum load of up to 150 pounds in the cargo bay with exceptional handling stability.

The Cargo Bike has a carefully handcrafted Aluminum frame, with a unique triangular tube construction. This design keeps the mass of the bike low, while maintaining a very rigid frame.

**Component selection** features a large range 21 speeds that enables the rider to power the loaded bike easily.

**Disc brakes** to provide excellent stopping power crucial when carrying loads.

**Cargo bay configuration** is mounted below the wheel axis center line. This is one of the key features that enables the cargo bike to handle so well even when fully loaded.

**Cargo bay mounts** enable the configuration of the bay to be customized in size and shape to fit the needs of the users.

**Kick stand** is mounted directly onto the main frame structure and makes it easy to load and unload the bike while parked upright.
